Rules and Competition Agreement

The purpose of the Potawatomi Festival Queen Pageant is to choose representatives from around the areas to act as hostesses throughout the Festival and to continue to promote the celebration of our Festival for the continued following year. Serving the community to the best of their ability with organizations, and different needed programs. In reaching these goals we set they are eligible for existing scholarships. All contestants and award recipients must be of good character and abide by the following rules.

1. All participants will need to be at the fairgrounds 2 hour before to check in and be back promptly at start times.
2. Must not lose numbers (\$5.00 replacement fee)
3. Never have been nor become married during her reign.
4. Not have been nor become pregnant during her reign.
5. Not be caught, accused, or convicted of any unlawful activity.
6. She must at all times conduct herself in a respectable manor worthy of being a role model to others in the community including adults and peers.
7. Be well dressed, groomed and respectful.
8. Completed entry form and the fees.
9. Under 18 years of age a companioned by adult at all times.
10. Participants in category 17-21 years of age are required to wear long formal gowns. (no exceptions)
11. Judges have final say no questions.
12. Be present for the festival both years crowned and the year turning over her crown.
13. Participate in as many functions as possible both as a court and individually.

Any of these rules broken will result in disqualifications and no refunds.

If the Jr. and Sr. Queens are unable at anytime to fulfill their reign the runner up will step up to finish fulfilling the reign for the festival.
