This is an invitation for you to attend the Potawatomi Festival as a Heritage, Arts, and Crafts vendor September 9-11, 2016. So please come and enjoy in the fun. Excitement is building with wonderful changes and added venues. WE ARE PROUD TO ANOUNCE THAT THIS 46TH ANNUAL FESTIVAL WILL BE AT THE GEORGETOWN ILLINIOS FAIR GROUNDS .We celebrate our festival Friday-Sunday; hours are Friday 11am -8pm, Saturday 10am-8pm and Sunday 9am-6pm. Opening ceremony begins at 11am Friday and closing ceremony at 6pm on Sunday. All vendors must remain open until 6pm Sunday unless other arrangements are made through the chair and committee approval or it could result in a penalty.

Each indoor space for arts/crafts/heritage is a 10x10 or larger upon early request. These spaces are for those vendors who have homemade products and merchandise. NOT RESALE. These spaces are \$35.00 & 20% after \$400.00. We are trying to educate our community on the fact that there still are wonderful crafts being made by people in the world still, by reminding people of things some have forgotten, and do not see on a regular basis. Camping is available for additional cost of \$25.00 a night to the fair grounds and showers for free. Confirmation of your spot is your fee and contract unless you send a self stamped addressed envelope to address above and we will send you something back. We allow set-up as early as Wednesday September 7th. **Return vendors must have contracts and money in by May 15th, 2016 to secure same spot.** Otherwise it is earliest post mark that will get what space.

Demonstrating is a wonderful way to pull people to your booth and is very much accepted and welcomed. We do have security throughout our festival and they are not always known or in any certain arrange time or clothing. However, even with security we cannot be held responsible for any loss of property, property damage, or injury to you and your help.

It is the wish of the Potawatomi Committee to make this a pleasant and safe event for vendors as well as visitors. Everyone will be expected to obey rules and instructions.
